



Legal guidance

When purchasing a home, you will need to obtain a Solicitor to guide you through the buying process. They will handle the conveyancing on your behalf and if purchasing on the Help to Buy: Shared Ownership scheme, they will explain the terms of your lease and communicate with the seller's Solicitor on your behalf.

If purchasing on the Help to Buy: Equity Loan scheme, your solicitor will also guide you through the process, working with your Financial Advisor to submit documents on your behalf via the Equity Loan Portal.

We do not provide a list of recommended Solicitors as most Property Developers and Housing Associations will have their own recommended panel. However, if you wish to use another Solicitor, contact [The Law Society](#) for help in finding the right Law Firm for you.

If you have a Help to Buy: ISA, your Solicitor will also provide advice and guidance and will claim your government bonus on your behalf on completion.
